SECRETARY' REPORT ----- HELP NEEDED

John Best, with the able assistance of his secretary, Lois Anderson, has for a number of years generously and graciously devoted time, energy and office facilities to the duplication of our Club's NEWSLETTER, not to mention the various other mailings which go out to Club members from time to time -- and all this at a reduced cost to the Club.

John has informed us that he no longer has the time needed to take care of these tasks for us, and has asked to be relieved of the responsibility. We hope that some other ITCA member many have an office with facilities to take over this job, at cost.

If anyone is able to do this, even for the next year or so, please let me know as soon as possible.

Specifically, what is needed is duplication, about six times a year, by Xerox or similar means, about 200 copies of six or seven double-sided typed pages (prepared by the Newsletter editor), the back page to be left blank to receive the address label. The pages need to be collated, stapled, folded, and mailed. Mailing labels, Xeroxed from a master list onto gummed label sheets, will be supplied by the ITCA Secretary.

This current Newsletter is being duplicated commercially, at, of course, the lowest figure quoted. If we have to continue to used commercial facilities we may have a problem producing this kind of Newsletter. Postage alone, for recent Newsletters, has been running about 28 cents per copy.

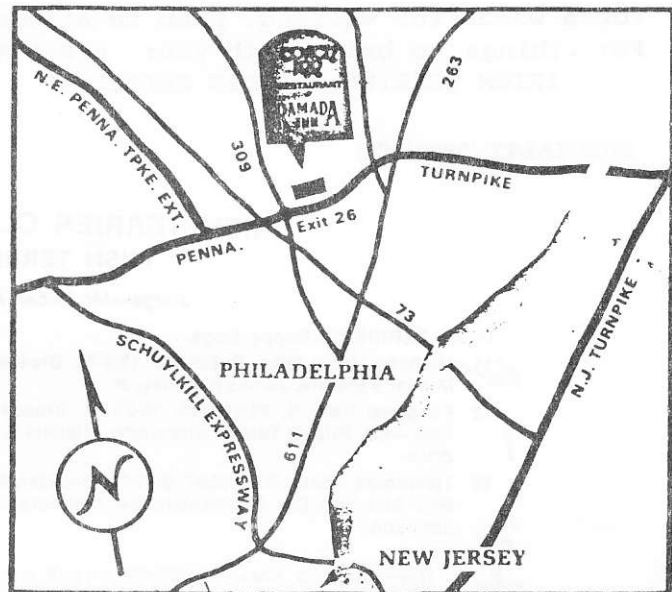

Judges' comment: Today is an exceptional day for me, for today I have judged the finest group of Irish Terriers than ever before. I am completely overwhelmed with the type of quality Irish Terriers in the ring today. I must complement your breeders as a whole for you are in the right direction in producing the best Irish Terriers possible.

(ITCA member Joseph M. O'Connor died Oct. 25, 1979. We asked Isabelle O'Connor if she would write something about Joe for the Newsletter. Mrs. O'Connor complied with the following.)

Joe O'Connor may not have been the easiest person in the world to know, but one thing was sure--he was a real lover of Irish Terriers. These feelings probably grew out of the stories told by his father who came from Ireland and often spoke fondly about the "Irish dogs" from the Old Country. One could say that he had a built-in love for the dogs long before he even owned his first one.

In 1968, Joe bought a four-month-old Irish Terrier puppy from Dr. Schnitzer. Ostensibly it was a gift for his wife, Isabelle, who was recovering from a serious automobile accident. He felt that "Brian would help her," and there was no question that Brian did. But Brian was also Joe's dog, and he would glow with pride whenever people complimented the dog he loved. He worked with his dog through puppyhood and the suggestion grew that Brian was worth showing. Neither Joe nor Isabelle felt they had a particular aptitude for showing dogs, but fortunately they met Susan Young in whom Joe had such confidence he formed a co-ownership with her and entrusted Brian's show career to her care. Herein was the start of a consuming hobby for Joe which was to last for the rest of his life. With Susan showing, Brian was able to earn his championship with flying colors as CH. GLANNAGALT ANASCAUL MICHAEL.

In September of 1969, two 12-week-old female puppies were bought from Pauline Puryear. In due time, they too won their championships as Ch. Riley's Meggin O'Shay and Ch. Riley's Irish Mist.

After Joe's retirement, he was able to devote full time to his dogs. He and Isabelle bought their house in Boxford in 1971. At once, Joe set to work converting the breezeway and the rear of the garage into a well designed and meticulously constructed kennel. He was a perfectionist in everything he put his mind and body to, and the work went on day and night until the essential parts were finished. Meanwhile, he had poured over maps and histories of Ireland. A suitable name for his kennel had to be found. With characteristic Irish whimsy he chose the name KINCORA. Not only was it an affectionate and lasting memorial to his first Irish Terrier, Brian, but Kincora was the site of the ancient Irish kingdom of King Brian!

Now the first whelping was to begin. In 1972, the first litter produced Ch. Kincora's Kerry-Ann Girl who, when shown by Susan, achieved a remarkable record of wins including the retirement of the Derg Trophy in New York, a trophy which had been in competition for approximately sixteen years.

For Joe, each of his dogs was an individual personality to be loved quietly and unobtrusively whether or not it won glory at the shows. He regarded each trait as precious and deserving of his daily gentle attention. Perhaps it is this care which is presently underlying the fact the Mistie and Maureen, at eleven years of age, have settled in so successfully as "house sitters" by day and "companions" by night to two working couples, an experiment which has out beautifully to the mutual advantage of all.

JOSEPH O'CONNOR, KINCORA IRISH TERRIERS, continued

Always Joe was interested in improving the Irish Terrier breed and very especially his own dogs. He strove for compensatory breeding and always line breeding. Sires were chosen outside the kennel and it was not until one year ago that he and Susan felt that Kincora was ready to use it's "home grows". This was the mating of the famous Kerry-Ann (Ch. Kincora's Kerry-Ann Girl) and Danny (Ch. Kincora's Out of My Wav). One of this litter, "Casey" (Kincora's Bases Loaded) not yet a year old, made Championship on Sunday, May 11th, at Windham, Conn. He finished with 2 - 4pt. majors, 2 - 3pt. majors and a single. He also has to his credit a Group II placement. But Joe never saw "Casey" in the ring. Joseph O'Connor passed away on October 25, 1979.
