

Along with the usual awards handed out at the annual banquet, ITCA after an extended hiatus bestowed the Good Sportman's Award on our longtime member and deserving lady, Joyce Wilson.

Many thanks to Nancy Petersen for wearing two hats: Specialty Show Coordinator for the year and Montgomery K.C. Show Chairperson. The responsibilities with either hat alone can be a challenge, and her undertaking was particularly difficult since she lives so far from Philadelphia. Once a year the Board plans to include in the Newsletter a questionnaire on the health of the breed. The questionnaire should be returned to ITCA anonymously. This survey will help pick up early warning signs of any health problems in the Irish. The breed currently seems to be very healthy and improving in quality. Credit goes to our members for their careful breeding programs.

Gary G. Hammer, Ph.D, has authored a manual of the Pedigrees of Irish Terrier Champions of American Kennel Club Record through December 31, 1977. With the help of Charles Ritter, Ph.D, Gary is updating the manual to the present. This is a particularly useful tool for those of you who are breeding Irish Terriers -- i.e. studying bloodlines to improve your future breeding program.

Bruce Petersen is hard at work editing the 1997 edition of the ITCA Breed Book. He is overseeing the completion of chapters authored by a panel of our learned members. The goal is to publish the most comprehensive breed book in the history of ITCA. I urge you to support this effort. Remember that this book in future years will be a collector's item.

Jim Cassity, Chairperson for Rescue, has carefully prepared a questionnaire which you will find in this Newsletter. Your input to Jim will add to his current database for available rescue support nationally.

Preparations are under way for the kickoff of our Centennial at Bucks County Kennel Club on May 4, 1996. Showchairs are Marianne Kehoe and Rose Marie Saporito. I have asked Rose Marie, Nancy Hetzel, and Diana Martin (ITCA Historian) to collect archival materials relative to the Club. We will exhibit them concurrently with the show. Some of the items are irreplaceable.)



The Irish Terrier Club of America was conceived on December 18, 1896 when Samuel D. Parker met with two other men at his office in Boston. A 3-line record of that meeting appears on page one of the Club's first log book. The subsequent record entry, nearly five pages long, captures the minutes of the first ITCA Annual Meeting on February 23, 1897. At this gathering, held at Madison Square Garden in New York concurrently with the Westminster K.C. show, the Club's officers were decided (see below).

Traditionally, the Club has considered 1897 as its founding year. Nevertheless, here we are in 1996, and centennial fever is already climbing. You may even see "1896-1996" on some posters. (If you do, just think of old man Parker and that seminal meeting!) You may also experience a little centennial hoopla at this year's Montgomery. Fine. But remember, plans call for the formal celebrating at Montgomery to wait until October 1997.




Irish Terrier Rescue

Judge's Critique

MONTGOMERY COUNTY K.C. IRISH TERRIER SPECIALTY October 8, 1995

Judge: Mrs. Lydia C. Hutchinson

(Transcribed from the judge's dictaphone tape recorded in the ring)

This is the Irish Terrier Club of America National Specialty at Montgomery County. We have a beautiful, beautiful day to judge these Irish.

I have just finished the <u>puppy dog 6 to 9 months class</u>. The dog in first [place] won for his correct balance. He has a typical head and typical topline with a slight rise over the loin. He is in very short coat, but that is forgivable in his class as he is a young puppy. The dog in second place has a lovely head and beautiful ears; they are somewhat superior to those of the first place dog. He is in fuller, very correct coat for the breed; however, his body balance isn't as correct and his rear quarters could stand some improvement. These are both very nice young dogs.

We have just completed the <u>puppy dog 9 to 12 months class</u>. Standing in first is a very correct-size, male, very typical Irish Terrier -- lovely ears, good head, nice level skull (no bumpiness to it), a very true mover, nice full coat of correct texture. He is a very pleasing dog. In second place is also a rather nice young dog. His skull needs to level out just a tad and hopefully lengthen a little bit. He is a very pleasant dog. His coat is just a tad short and he is a little bit weak in his pasterns, but he has promise. Third place is a larger dog, a little bit over the standard -- a very happy dog, who needs to settle in his movement; and if he settles in his movement, this one has promise. The fourth place dog has a coat just barely breaking through with not the head that I was looking for today.

We are now done with the 12 to 18 months dog class. Standing in first place is a very, very special dog. This dog has quality teaming out of his pores, lovely typical head, ear carriage and that wicked look in the eye that is just so appealing. He is in prime, prime coat condition. He moved magnificently. He is pushing the mark for size but is not offensive in his size -- good tail set and just a very soundly constructed and typey dog. Standing in second is a dog in less coat, but he has good hard hair -- a lighter colored dog. As he improves in his showmanship, he will come along. He is pushing being a bit too short in body, but this may change as he matures. Standing in third is a dog that is very short of coat today and could improve in movement. His body balance is correct, however, and he is a happy dog and shows himself nicely.

We have just judged the bred by exhibitor class. In first is a

correct size dog in full coat, a little bit heavier body type. As he matures, he may not wind up staying racey enough. He has a nice head and nice ear carriage and ear size. He showed well and moved well. I would hope that he wouldn't get clunky as he gets older. In second place is a very young dog who needs ring experience. He does have some promise. He was hesitant to let me examine him today, obviously because he is not used to being in a show environment. I think when he gets happier about it and learns what he is supposed to do, he will go places.

The open dog class has just been finished. Standing in first is a lovely correct size dog, in good coat, moving well, beautiful outline, a very lovely balance as he carries himself around the ring. His size and balance outline are just outstanding. He is a little lazy with the use of his ears, but he can use them properly. Standing in second is a heavier bodied dog, a little heavier boned, cobbier, beautiful body condition, but a slightly different type dog. In third is a dog more the type of the first place dog, not quite as true a mover and not in good hair today. Standing in fourth is a dog in only single coat, good body shape and nice balance, proper length of back, needs improvement in his shoulders and front action.

The decision for winners dog is based on correct size, outline and shape, and the dog from the open class went winners. He just stole my eye in the way he used himself with such super carriage and outline as he moved. The 12-to-18-months dog went reserve. He is a different type dog than the WD, heavier boned, a little bit cobbier in his balance. I wouldn't call him cobby but a little shorter bodied; he does excel in the density of his coat. So in the final analysis, it came down to type. [An after-thought] on the winners dog: the dog I put up for winners excelled in shoulders and racey look.

Now we are on puppy bitches 6 to 9 [months]. First is a bitch of the very same type as the dog that went winners, a feminine version, a very nice body shape. Once she settled down, she moved very true, using her ears well. She has a little wrinkle on her skull, which I hope will flatten out as she matures. She is just coming into new hair today, but in the puppy class I forgive that. Second to a bitch in beautiful condition with a full dense coat, a heavier bodied bitch and not as racey looking as the first one. The second place puppy bitch is soundly put together, moved well and showed well. Third place to a bitch that needs to settle with her ears, right ear in particular; nice level head, nice muzzle, nice body balance; could be just a little stronger in her rear movement. And fourth to a bitch very similar in type to the first and third place bitches, but her ears are still flying away at this age.

This is puppy bitches 9 to 12 months. First place bitch is a puppy holding her blue ribbon in her mouth, chewing it up! A very nice type puppy, very lovely shoulders and reach of neck, good body balance, lovely tail set and tail carriage. Her ears need to settle a bit; but other than that, she is a lovely puppy. Second place is also a good coated puppy, nice angles to her, not using her tail quite as well as the winner, but a very commendable puppy. She should do well in the

future. Third place is a good coated puppy again, very much the same shape and type of the two above her, good head planes, slight wrinkling on the skull right now (but I know that can improve with age), not quite as clever in her rear movement as the two ahead of her. Fourth place, again a very nice type bitch in good condition, but not happy on the day; but when she has a better attitude, she will do well. She is what an Irish Terrier should look like.

I just examined the 12 to 18 [months] class. I like the bitch standing in first. She is still quite immature, but she has that wonderful reach of neck, lay back of shoulder that I am looking for today, bang-on tail set, uses herself very nicely, quite full of herself, and uses her ears nicely, good bend of stifle, nice bitch all together and a nice coat. Second to a taller bitch, racey looking none-theless, very much the type of the first bitch. Her neck isn't set on as well as the first bitch. Third, also a biggish kind of a bitch. Type is okay on this bitch; she just needs to settle in her movement and gain some confidence in the ring. This exhibitor has shown all his dogs to me today in beautiful full, dense coat and I appreciate that fact.

Bred by exhibitor class is a typey, showy bitch, nice size bitch. She is a little short on furnishings today, but her body coat is adequate. I like her body balance. I like her type. I would change her rear movement, which is rather stilted; but overall a worthy specimen.

This is the American bred class and a very strong class it was. All three of these bitches are nice type Irish. The first place bitch is in magnificent condition; her coat is right, nice and dense and full. She moved very nicely. She has an adequate head; it is not extreme in any way [and] certainly fits her. Second place, a very attractive bitch, maybe a shade taller that the other one, but acceptable in size, a lovely body shape, and a really, really nice bitch of championship caliber. She is slightly bouncey in her front movement, and that is what lost it for her today. Third place is a really correct size bitch, a nice bitch that could be a little stronger in her rear movement; and unfortunately her mouth isn't totally correct, but she has a fabulous coat and was shown in beautiful condition.

I have just finished the <u>open bitch class</u>. The first two are a very evenly matched pair. Both are in lovely condition. They have hard, hard coats: the same size, correct size, same body balance, and it was a very tough call in this strong class. In the final analysis, the one standing in first used her ears better. The second place bitch is a very worthy bitch, maybe not quite as free a mover as number one; but her outline, her neck, her shoulders are just lovely, as are her head and expression. She could use a darker eye. Third place bitch didn't make the most of herself, but again I loved her body shape, and I loved the condition in which she was shown, and I liked her head and expression. Fourth place bitch may be a slightly heavier headed bitch, but still very Irish in outlook and shown in lovely condition. All four are very worthy bitches.

Winners bitch went to the open bitch. She stood out in the winners class. Overall quality of the bitches was very good. I was pleased with what I had. Reserve winners bitch was second in the open class and again she stood out in this class. I did like the winners class, but a lot of them are not mature and are not in coat to take the points on a day like this.

The <u>veteran dog and the veteran bitch</u> seem to enjoy themselves being here, especially the veteran dog. The crowd started clapping for him, and in fact he started barking right back at the crowd and was just having a wonderful time. I appreciate the exhibitors bringing them to me.

This has been a most beautiful <u>class of BOB dogs</u> and a very difficult decision. All three of these dogs -- the best of breed dog, the best of winners dog and the best of opposite bitch -- are absolutely gorgeous Irish Terriers! There are just the minutest differences between the BOB and the BOS. The BOB dog is in the most magnificent condition. His body is lean, he is hard, he is muscled, and his coat is impeccable. He exudes type for an Irish Terrier. There are a couple of little places where you would change him -- he could use his ears slightly better -- but his type is so outstanding that you can't deny him. I have already commented on the BOW dog. The BOS is just a beautiful, beautiful bitch. She has a wonderful head and wonderful use of her ears. This is the bitch that I have given an all-breed BIS to and a very deserving one. She was in very good condition on that day, as well as today, and I continue to admire her.

Overall the condition of the breed right now I think is superb and I am very much impressed with the quality. Structure has improved so much and there were a lot of sound movers today. I would say 80% of the entries moved beautifully. The dogs that got the top awards — the BOB, the BOW, the BOS and the WB — all had lovely free-flowing movement without any bounciness, and I rewarded that. Also the breed, I think, is strong in temperament; and coat texture for the most part was very good. Heads were quite good and ear carriage has improved an awful lot. Mouths were marvelous; with one exception in the entire entry, the mouths were perfect. I would like to say that there are a couple of areas where I think you need to be paying attention. One would be the tail sets on some of the dogs; and rears were a little weak on a few of them. There were a few with feet that were not ideal. But for the most part, feet and pasterns were strong. I am just pleased that the breed is in such good condition, and I hope that this continues in the future. Thank you for having me judge this wonderful national specialty.

Addendum

In the Group ring at the end of the day, I was seated near long-time Terrier fancier Bea Marvin. Not realizing I had judged Irish, she proclaimed to all within earshot, "Look at that magnificent Irish! What a coat! That's the way they should look, not like the baby seals I've seen in recent years." Needless to say, I was in total agreement.

There will be an exhibit of archival materials. Ms. Kehoe called for materials suitable for the display. The exhibit will be protected by bonded and insured security guards. Items in possession of ITCA will be exhibited. The original minutes from December 1896 and first meeting in February 1897 plus the records of dog awards and club business from 1897 to 1959. Exhibit Committee is Rose Marie Saporito (Chair), Diana Martin, ITCA Historian and Nancy Hetzel. Available for sale is a Commemorative Poster produced by the New York Club to help fund the Centennial kick-off at Bucks County K.C. The posters are \$40.00 if purchased at the banquet and \$43.00 if mailed to the purchaser. Contact Marianne Kehoe for more information.

RESCUE COMMITTEE Jim Cassity will update his computer database to reflect those who have rescue dogs, info on the dog, and the names of those who want one. Questionnaires will be mailed in the Newsletter to ask for volunteers to rescue Irish in need. 1994 placements: 4 dogs on the West Coast, 3 in New England, and 1 in Illinois. Cookbooks, notebooks and stationery are all available for purchase with proceeds going to the rescue efforts. Posters are available to place in shelters with a space on the poster to write in a phone number for a contact person.

BREED BOOK FOR 1996 Bruce Petersen reminded the members that the last Breed Book authored by ITCA was 1983. First drafts of all Chapters for the 1997 Breed Book have been written. Thank you all for all the generous donations. Advertising space will be available in the book at the following rates: \$175.00 for 2 pages, \$100.00 for 1 page, \$60.00 for 1/2 page and \$35.00 for 1/4 page. Donations of \$250.00 and up to \$499.00 will receive one free page of advertising. Donations of \$500.00 or more will receive two free pages of advertising. There will be available a prepublication price, as yet undetermined, for less than the post-publication price.

HEALTH STUDY OF THE BREED Peggy Gill reported that AKC has requested breed clubs to study the state of health of their breed. AKC would like to see this as an ongoing project and data collection process. The last survey was conducted in 1984, and the pool was not large enough to be significant. The Board has voted to monitor the Breed's health by enclosing in the Newsletter a questionnaire once a year to poll the membership on areas of concern. The Education Committee will compose the questionnaire, compile and publish the results from the Newsletter survey. A more in-depth study will be conducted if a problem is identified. Efforts to contain costs have included streamlining committees and raising dues \$1.50 per member to a total of \$18.00. Of the monies in the bank, \$9,000 has been earmarked for the Breed Book publication and for the Rescue operations.
