

The Itish Terrier Puppy Referral Service

The Irish Terrier Puppy Referral service exists to assist Irish Terrier Club of America breeders in placing their puppies and older dogs with new owners who understand the responsibilities of dog ownership and have the facilities to give their pet a healthy and happy home.

Breeders with puppies or older dogs they wish to place inform the coordinator of the number of puppies in the litter, names of the sire and dam, date of birth and sex of the puppies. The coordinator lists this information in the "Litter Basket" and uses this guide in answering phone calls and letters inquiring about Irish Terriers. "The Litter Basket" is printed in the Irish Terrier Newsletter which is sent to members every other month.

Each inquirer is sent a copy of the "Litter Basket," a letter of introduction, a breeders list for his area, and a copy of the pamphlet "An Introduction to Owning an Irish Terrier." The letter of introduction informs him of ITCA, how to become a member, and where to get the Breed Book of the Irish Terrier. The breeders list divide breeders into East, West, South and Midwest, and each inquirer receives the list for his area.

To keep the "Litter Basket" up-to-date, puppy information is printed one time only, but can be repeated if the coordinator is so informed.

ITCA maintains an ad in "Dog World" magazine informing readers of the ITCA Puppy Referral program, and giving the name, address, and phone number of the puppy coordinator. AKC has a breeder referral program and gives inquirers the name and phone number of the Irish Terrier coordinator. We average around 35 calls each month.

Frequent questions asked by inquirers are — "Why is the Irish Terrier not more popular?"; "What is the cost?"; "Are the breeders reputable?"

I, in turn ask, "Why do you want an Irish Terrier?"; "What is your family situation?"; "Do you have children?"; "A fenced yard?"; "Any other dogs?"; and "Will the puppy be a house dog?"

The coordinator does not discuss price other than a general figure, pedigrees, show dogs, blood lines, or breeders.

The coordinator attempts to get up-to-date information out promptly, to treat each breeder equally, and to get puppies into responsible, caring families.

WHAT IS YOUR OPINION?

Not too long ago, I was speaking with a friend on the grooming of terriers. She was quick to explain, "I would never strip my dog, that's too mean!" So, instead, she uses the electric clippers. No doubt, given several terriers to groom, they would all come out of her grooming hands looking like clones! However, I have read a lot of controversy surrounding the "inhumane treatment" of dogs...all for show." Some examples might be, ear cropping, tail docking, dew-claw removal and stripping of coats. What is your opinion?

ALSO,

I am confused. Where does the notion of "Breeding for..." come from? I've heard breeders, (not necessarily Irish), state... "Well I breed for the conformation ring.", or, "I am an obedience breeder.", or, "You may not win any conformation titles with my line, but you won't find a more reliable, sound temperament!" I ask, "What's going on here"? Can we not find all traits within the same line? Is it that one breeder or another may simply take on more interest in a given area and pursue that? Or, is that to say that if you purchase from an "Obedience" breeder you may not make the mark in conformation, or suffer temperament-wise? In my mind, (simple though it may be!), a dog or bitch bred for, (to) standard should fall into place in all categories of competition. Function follows structure, does it not? I pity the overly short, stocky dog trailing the lithe fox in the field, or failing jumps in agility! Again, is it not possible to "get it all" in one package? Does time and money, etc. interfere with that becoming a reality? To what extent are these factors considered in pairing up mates for a new litter? Is there room for improvement for a more well-rounded balance? If breeders are to go too far in one direction or another, then where's the uniformity,? Ultimately, it seems the standard becomes buried, choked-out by the differing "specialties". Some of you may inform me to, "Dream on!, but I would like to know..., What is your opinion?
