PRESIDENT'S COLUMN



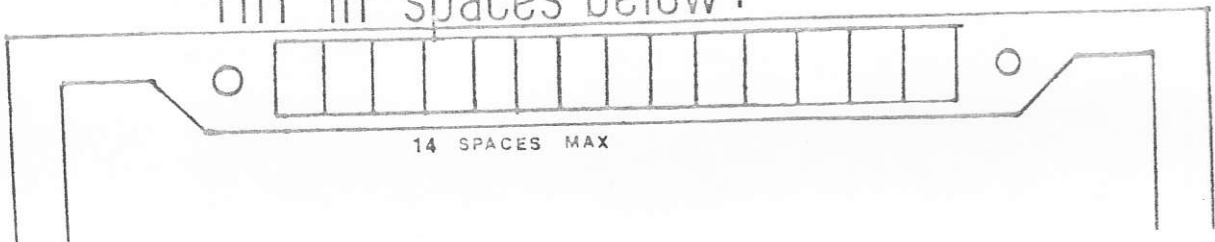

In over 60 years in working with dogs, Father Joe has owned and handled Wire and Smooth Fox Terriers, Scotties and Irish Terriers. He says his favorite breed is the Irish, or red Terrier. The Monsignor attributes much of his success to his handler Henry McGill. McGill has handled many of Father Joe's champions during their careers.

Will you please convey to the club that I very much appreciated being invited to judge the breed at Montgomery.

I was very surprised at the large entry and good quality of almost every exhibit. Two judges who came over to watch commented afterwards on the continual improvement of the breed. I told them the Irish Terrier is now an important competitor in the major league especially with all the Best In Show winners and Group winners, with more on the way!

The following three points, which were immediately apparent to me, are offered so that members and exhibitors can, hopefully, benefit from my observations.

Ears. The expressions on some of the exhibits were ruined by poor ears. Had these same dogs and bitches had good ears the placings could have been different.

Eyes. As I stood in front of each exhibit to look at it's expression I noticed quite a few with larger eyes than I like. In some cases the eyebrows had been shortened- either plucked or scissored thus emphasizing size of eye.

Rear Movement. It was disappointing to go over some otherwise good specimens only to find that as they moved away their movement was poor.

In general there were more without the above three conditions but enough with one or more of them to warrant bringing it to the attention of Irish Terrier breeders.

Coats, temperament and condition were very good and I feel very confident in the breed's future. Sincerely, Dennis Barnes
