PRESIDENT'S COLUMN

We are in a period now which surely will be red-tabbed in ITCA history for the surge of Irish Terriers into the Best-In Show category. For years an Irish Terrier Best-In-Show was a rarity. During the past quarter of a century, Ch. Wahoo Satellite won a BIS in 1958 and Ch. Green Starr's Gold Strike in 1964. It was 11 years before another Irish Terrier, Ch. Glannagalt Now Peace, was chosen BIS. However Irish Terrier Group placements had begun to increase, which could have been a tip-off as to what was to come. In 1979 Ch. Sunny's Pretty Queen took a BIS, followed by Ch. Blackacre Barrister and Ch. Rockledge's Mr. Morgan, and more recently, Ch. The Irishman's Mr. Rockledge and Ch. Rockledge's Mick Michael, the latter with four BIS, as of this writing.

The reasons for this unusual surge in Irish Terrier show successes are not entirely clear to this observer, but the development is none-the-less gratifying.

What might be called the show of the century is coming up in 1984. The American Kennel Club is planning to commemorate its 100th anniversary by organizing a two-day dog show, benched, on November 17-18, 1984. The site will be Philadelphia where the AKC held its first meeting in 1884. You will be hearing more about this.

The French member of our Club, M. Jean Claude Bertoncelli, is an equestrian as well as a dog fancier, with a special interest in endurance. In a recent letter he wrote: "My dream is to participate in the TEVIS Cup Race (a 100 mile 24 hour competition in California). Perhaps another member of ITCA also is interested in horses and could give me information about the TEVIS Cup Race." It would be helpful to have a "Breeders List" of those expecting to have puppies throughout the year.

Occasionally, I receive letters from buyers or sellers informing me of results of referrals. I appreciate this and think it is helpful in evaluating the referral service.

I would estimate that over one fourth of the inquiries come through ITCA members. I feel these are more serious inquiries than many which come through the Dog World ad. There are not many requests for older dogs. I know of three that have been placed during the past six months.

The Irish Terrier elegantly is put together and walks with great dignity. It has piercing eye-to-eye contact, announcing to all that herein lies "the size of the fight in the dog." Another straight measurement!

OBEDIENCE NEWS

Lately, I have heard or read about using some very hard corrective methods in obedience training the Irish Terrier. One report, was that the Instructor used a plastic pipe to hit the dog across the head to get its attention. The other, was that the Instructor urged the handler of the dog to swing him just because the dog wanted to fight with another dog in the class. The two corrections used are much to harsh and should be used only as the last resort. I have found it necessary to swing a dog only once in the nine years that I have been teaching obedience and that was on a dog which attacked his owner and then me. This was a large dog and had to be controlled quickly. Never hit the dog over the head with anything....

For those of you in obedience, here's a few corrections that will work on the Irish:

- 1. A good swift jerk on the collar with a loud "NO".
- Grip the collar under the dog's neck & shake him very hard back and forth. Again, a loud no in a strong voice.
- 3. A swift slap under the dog's chin.
- 4. With the open palm of your hand, hit the dog on the side of his chest forcing the wind from his lungs. This is not as cruel as it sounds and the force is not great enough to knock the dog off his feet.

Try these and the results you will get with obedience training your Irish Terrier will well be worth your time and troubles. Remember, you wanted that Irish Terrier who has been bred for many years to be a tough, rugged little red dog.


