

October 4, 1986 Holiday Inn Northeast, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania

Present: Robert Peters, Ellis West, Marie Johnson, Jeanene MacDonald, Phyllis Kendrick, Edna Mae Sillavan, Sue Griffiths, George Kidd, Diana Martin, Joe Sayres, June Kennedy, Cory Rivera, Also present were new Board members David Carscadden and Joyce Wilson; AKC Delegate Mary Gately; hospitality chairperson Diane Piantieri, puppy referral coordinator Mary Jane Oudendyk. Board member Ed Worth had sent word that he would not be able to attend the meeting and gave his proxy to Bob Peters.

The annual meeting of the Bdard of Governors was called to order by President Robert Peters at 9:30 a.m.

The Board agreed to adjourn at 10:30 in order to prepare for judging at the Devon Dog Show later that same day. The Board would be called back for their second meeting 10 minutes after the conclusion of the annual meeting of the ITCA.

Diane Piantieri was present to give her report as hospitality chairperson, and the Board thanked her for her excellent work on hospitality for the weekend. Diane reported that the George Washington Lodge at King of Prussia would now accept dogs and had offered us rooms for next year at a price of less than \$40 per room.

MOTION: That we contract with the George Washington at King of Prussia. If for any reason that does not follow through, Diane has the Board's permission to reserve the Holiday Inn Northeast. Seconded. Vote: Unanimous.

Reports of Officers

The secretary reported that minutes of the last meeting had been mailed to Board members and appeared in the Newsletter. Minutes were accepted as printed. Membership totals 354, the largest number at least in the last 30 years.

The treasurer distributed a detailed report which shows that our balance on hand stayed approximately the same during the past year.

Special Reports

1. Education Committee. Mrs. Isabelle O'Connor, chairman of the Education Committee submitted a written report which was read by the secretary. Mrs. O'Connor recommended that an educational seminar be held in conjunction with the Montgomery County weekend in 1987. She suggested three possible speakers: Dr. fonald Patterson, on medical genetics; Dr. Phyllis Holst, on the art of breeding dogs; Dr. Jacob Mosier, on the team approach between veterinarian, owner and breeder. There were recommendations from Board members for Dr. Patterson, who will be working on a project with the AKC which will eventually involve the ITCA and for Dr. Mosier, who is a highly respected speaker on canine pediatrics.

After much discussion:

MOTION: That we invite Dr. Mosier as our first choice. Seconded. SUBSTITUTE MOTION: That we invite Dr. Donald Patterson. Seconded. Vote: 6 in favor of Dr. Patterson; 6 in favor of Dr. Mosier. President Peters broke the tie in favor of Dr. Donald Patterson.

Discussion also centered around when the seminar would be held, with Friday night and Saturday afternoon suggested.

MOTION: That the seminar be held on Friday evening from 7-10 p.m. Seconded. Vote: Unanimous.

MOTION: That the Board of Governors hold their meeting during the day on Friday, working around the Hatboro show. Seconded. Vote: Unanimous.

2. Breed History Committee. Diana Martin handed out a letter that this committee, also consisting of Marilyn Shaw and Renee Bullard, had sent to the regional clubs. The letter requested copies of newsletters, annual reports from each club, memorabilia of historic interest to the Club, new champions and obedience degree winners, best in show winners, and show results from specialty shows.

MOTION: That Diana receive, maintain and calendar the memorabilia items. Seconded. Vote: Unanimous.

Jeanene MacDonald volunteered to computerize the material sent to the committee.

- 3. AKC Delegate. Mary Gately reported that things seem to be running smoothly. The AKC has recommended that more attention be given to the American Bred Class so that the Open class does not dominate the shows.
- 4. New Trophy Committee. Chairman Sue Griffiths distributed her report which indicated the committee is still working on the conditions and wording of each trophy. Sue indicated she hopes these awards can be submitted for Poard approval so that they can be awarded at the next annual meeting.
- 5. Judges Education Committee. Chairman Ellis West discussed the project with the Board, outlining some of the history of the project and committee. Ellis indicated that, since the Board knew of his opposition to parts of the project yet still elected him chairman, he felt this meant the Board favored a "go slow" approach. He said he felt the video could be a useful and entertaining bit, but the AKC demands were severe on Clubs the size of the ITCA. He hopes we can work with the membership to produce the video.

Because the time was now 10:30 a.m., there was a motion to adjourn and meet again 10 minutes after the annual meeting. Seconded. Vote: Unanimous.

Minutes of Second Meeting

Saturday, October 4, 1986 Philadelphia, Pennsylvania

Present: Bob Peters, June Kennedy, George Kidd, Joyce Wilson, David Carscadden, Diana Martin, Ellis West, Cory Rivera, Martha Salem Sue Griffiths, Joe Sayres, Jeanene MacDonald, Marie Johnson. Also present were Mary Jane Oudendyk, puply referral coordinator; and John B. Kelly, Chairman of the INCA flag committee.

The second meeting of the Irish Terrier Club of America Board of Covernors was called to order at 10:00~p.m.

John Kelly was asked to report on progress of the flag committee. Mr. Kelly presented several possibilities based on the INCA medallions. The Board chose from the various sketches and made some suggestions on the design. A 3 x 5 flag to be used at specialty shows at a cost of \$230 and 500 smaller flags for club members to purchase at a cost of \$2.60 each was recommended.

MOTION: That flags be ordered and sold based on these suggestions and prices. Seconded. Vote: Unanimous.

Mary Jane Oudendyk reported on the puppy referrals during the last year. Over 300 requests for information, puppies or older dogs were received. Mary Jane submitted her resignation as puppy referral coordinator.

MOTION: That the Board give a vote of thanks to Mary Jane for her work in this position. Seconded. Vote: Unanimous.

Phyllis Kendrick, chairman of the 1987 traveling specialty, reported that Dennis Barnes would judge the show and Mary Gately had been asked to judge the sweepstakes. The show will be held in conjunction with the Old Dominion Kennel Club show, part of the Cherry Blossom Circuit.

Diana Martin reported that the Irish Terrier Club of Northern California will host the 1988 traveling specialty, with the show held either during their spring specialty or their fall specialty held during the second weekend of September. The Board preferred the September timing but a question was raised as to whether a Club can hold two national specialties within a short time frame. The secretary was instructed to call the AKC for a clarification.

There was a call for volunteers for the 1989 and 1990 traveling specialties. The Chicago regional club volunteered for the 1989 traveling show and Southern California volunteered for the 1990 specialty.

MOTION: That the 1989 Traveling Specialty be held in Chicago in conjunction with the Great Lakes Terrier Club. Seconded. Vote: Unanimous.

MOTION: That the 1990 Traveling Specialty be held in Southern California. Seconded. Vote: Unaninous.

The Board was asked whether they wanted to videotape the 1987 specialty at Montgomery County.

MOTION: That the Irish Terrier entry at the 1987 Montgomery County show be videotaped. Seconded. Vote: Unanimous.

Appointments

Nominations for appointments had been made by mail previous to the meeting.

Puppy Referral Service: Peggy Gill was nominated.

MOTION: That Peggy Gill be asked to serve as puppy referral coordinator. Seconded. Vote: Unanimous.

There followed some discussion on the duties of the puppy referral coordinator and how it should be coordinated with secretary. The Board felt that there should be some guidelines on how we expect the position to be handled.

MOTION: That the former puppy referral coordinators and the secretary and new puppy referral coordinator draw up a list of recommended procedures, and that Margaret Stone should serve as chairperson.

Seconded. Vote: Unanimous.

Newsletter:

MOTION: That Karen Worth continue as newsletter editor. Seconded. Vote: Unanimous.

Hospitality, Montgomery County

MOTION: That Diane Piantieri be asked to serve again as hospitality chairman. Seconded. Vote: Unanimous.

A point was raised that the choice of hospitality chairman is really not a Board decision, but that of the specialty show chairman. It was also noted, kowever, that the job of hospitality has become much more demanding than in the past and is now a year around duty.

MOTION: That in future years the Montgomery County show chairman should be able to choose their hospitality chairman and other specialty show chairmen. seconded. Vote: Unanimous.

Judicial Selection Committee:

MOTION: That Marge Andre serve as chairman, with Dennis Barnes and Laura Lie Nielsen as other members. Seconded. Vote: Unanimous. Nominating Committee:

MOTION: That the 1987 Nominating Committee be made up of Lori Sundheimer, chairperson; Jean Hall and Mary Roberts with Marge Andre and Mary O'Brien as alternates. Seconded. Vote: Unanimous.

Specialty Show Chairmen:

February, 1987: Several were nominated, but representatives from the New York area offered to discuss the job with the nominees.

February, 1988: June Kennedy volunteered to chair this show.

MOTION: That June Kennedy serve as chairman of the 1988 February specialty. Seconded. Vote: Unanimous.

Montgomery County, 1987: Joan Groves was nominated.

MOTION: That Joan Groves serve as chairman of the 1987 Montgomery County show. Seconded. Vote: Unanimous.

Other Business

Jeanene MacDonald recommended that, as a token of friendship between the ITCA and the Canadian Irish Terrier Association, we offer a challenge trophy to be awarded at their specialties. David Carscadden, president of the CITA, thanked the Board for their offer, however they do not as yet have official recognition from the Canadian Kennel Club, although it is hoped it will be official by 1988, the centennial of the CKC. After some discussion on what assistance might be offered to the Canadian Club,

MOTION: That the secretary should write the president of the CITA asking what assistance the ITCA can offer. Seconded. Vote: Unanimous.

Ellis West noted that we still have a fairly good supply of Handbooks left and we will soon be planning the next handbook. Therefore, he suggested:

MOTION: That we offer a reduced rate on the purchase of breed books in bulk quantities, \$9.00 per book including postage in sets of 5 or more and ask the secretary to notify regional secretaries of such. Seconded, Vote: Unanimous.

Marie Johnson noted some ambiguity in the wording of the instructions for selecting specialty show judges. Also, she mentioned that we are working on a very short time frame when we choose specialty judges only two years in advance. Therefore,

MOTION: That next year we choose judges for two years, 1989 and 1990. Seconded. Vote: Unanimous.

MOTION: That the following words be added to clarify instruction No. 3a (1) of the procedures: "from the year of balloting" so that the instruction will read: "Ineligible judges are: (1) those who have judged an ITCA Specialty in the previous two calendar years from the time of balloting;" Seconded. Vote: Unanimous.

Jeanene MacDonald suggested that we keep three separate scrapbooks, one for each of the specialties with photos of winners, name of owner, judge, and to go back as far as we can and keep this record current. There was a suggestion that these photos be in black and white since most color pictures fade in time. Jeanene offered to look into the exact procedure and notify the board.

A question was raised as to whether a dog which has finished its championship between the time of entry and the date of the show can still be shown in the sweepstakes. There were differing points of view and no notion was presented, although many Board members felt that owners should keep track of points and follow the instructions of no champions being shown in the sweepstakes.

Four applications for membership were presented to the Board for approval, All were approved unanimously.

All business before the Board being completed, there was a motion to adjourn which was seconded and unanimously approved.

IRISH TERRIER CLUB OF AMERICA Minutes of the Annual Meeting

Saturday, October 4, 1986 Holiday Inn Northeast, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania

The annual meeting of the Irish Terrier Club of America was called to order at 6:30 p.m. after a quorum was established. The minutes of the last meeting were approved as published in the newsletter.

President Bob Peters called for a moment of silence in remembrance of three of our members who passed away during the last year: Frank Kennedy, Sandy Neider and Tom Robinson.

Secretary Marie Johnson reported that there are currently 354 members with 4 regular memberships and one junior membership application pending. She thanked Mary Jane Oudendyk, puppy referral coordinator, and Martha Salem and Karen Worth, newsletter editors, for their work during the past year. Finally, she announced that the Board of Governors has approved holding an educational seminar next year during the Montgomery County weekend. Hopefully the speaker will be Dr. Donald Patterson of the University of Pennsylvania and the seminar will be held on Friday evening, October 2. Mrs. Isabelle O'Connor will coordinate plans for this seminar, and members were asked to schedule this seminar in their plans for next year's Montgomery County weekend.

Treasurer Jeanene MacDonald reported that our balance has remained about the same over the year.

Bob Peters thanked the outgoing Board members who had served the Club well over the past three years: Phyllis Kendrick, Mary Roberts, Edna Mae Sillavan and Liz Wilson. He also thanked this year's specialty show chairmen: Joan Groves, February specialty; Nan Bruner, traveling specialty; and Mary Gately, AKC Delegate and ITCA delegate to the Associated Terriers and Diane Piantieri, hospitality chairman for the weekend.

The membership heard reports from regional clubs Northern California, New York, Southern California and the Canadian Irish Terrier Association. David Carscadden, president of the Canadian club, announced that their group was growing and very enthusiastic. The club publishes a newsletter and will hold booster shows in Ottawa and Nova Scotia. He thanked the Southern California Club for its generosity of trophies for winners dog and winners bitch at their last show.

Ellis West, chairman of the Judges Education Committee was asked to report on the progress of this committee. Ellis gave a brief history of this project: Originally started with seminars for judges including pictures and notes from breeders and gradually the AKC added the slide show and asked that each member club empower a three person committee to speak on behalf of their club. Last year at the annual meeting the members present voted to have the entire membership approve or disapprove the presentation. After many clubs had finished or nearly finished this project the AKC changed it to a video tape format. Last year the chairman of the ITCA committee, Joe Sayres, resigned as chairman because of a heavy work load and Ellis West was appointed by the Board to take on the job of chairman, which Ellis said was interesting since he was opposed to some parts

of this program. The AKC has put restrictions on filming of the video tape which he feels will be particularly difficult for the ITCA to meet, such as filming in an East Coast location, filming at times other than at specialty show weekends, etc. Ellis was hopeful that some of these restrictions could be lifted to accommodate our membership. He hopes that our presentation can emphasize the positive and wants to view other clubs' efforts and get feedback from these clubs that have finished their videos. He will be contacting the committee to begin work on this video.

Chris Ward announced that the traveling specialty will be held April 19 in conjunction with the Old Dominion Kennel Club Show. Dennis Barnes will judge.

Mary Welch, member of the 1986 Nominating Committee, read the slate that was presented to the voters:

Bob Peters President Vice President Ellis West Marie Johnson Secretary Jeanene NacDonald Treasurer AKC Delegate Mary Gately David Carscadden Board Members 1989 John Childers Martha Salem Joyce Wilson 1988 June Kennedy

Because there were no additional nominations the secretary was asked to cast one vote for the slate.

Nancy Hetzel, specialty show coordinator, said that all the challenge trophies were in order.

Mrs. Hetzel also showed a print of a Maude Earl painting that Mrs. Jones' daughter was making available for sale.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:15 p.m. A social hour and dinner followed.

IRISH TERRIER CLUB OF AMERICA 1986 FINANCIAL REPORT

SEFTEMBER 23. 1986

Dues and initiations remain our primary source of income, with a total of \$5716.90 paid. This is an increase of \$636.40 over 1985 because of increased membership.

The Trophy Fund, had an income of more than \$2500.00, including John Best's generous donation of \$1000.00. However, it was put into the red by the expenses of correcting the engravings on the Martha Hall Trophy, and purchasing the replicas for that trophy, which were several years in arrears.

The specialties of 1986, including Montgomery of 1985, all lost money, mainly due to the high judging fees. Otherwise, all were well supported with entries and catalog advertising, a big improvment over the previous year.

The 1983 Breed Book sales remain a bit slow, with around 72 copies sold. With an inventory of over 600 BOOKS, perhaps we should encourage all breeders to present one with each puppy sold, by allowing a discount on quantity sales. We should be thinking ahead and planning on publishing a centinnial breed book in 1996.

The Newsletter, continues to run near \$1000.00 per year, and will remain so, unless we can persuade some members to reproduce and compile it free of charge.

Medallions and Jewelry were both costly in 1986 due to the necessity of replacing depleted stock; but, what we have now on hand should last for two or three years.

As reported last year the club remains in good financial condition due to the continued good support of the membership. There is a balance of \$8499.25, a rise of approximately \$425.00 for this time period in 1985.

I WAS PLEASED WITH MY WINNERS AND HAPPY TO SEE THAT MRS. YOUNG THOUGHT ENDUGH OF THE IRISH TO GIVE IT A 4TH PLACE IN AN EXCELLENT TERRIER FINAL.


